Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a public meeting at 13850 Cutten Road, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77069, said address being a meeting place of the District.

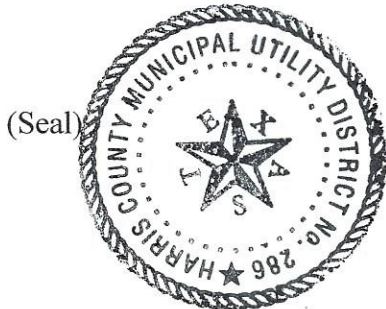
The meeting will be held on Monday, October 7, 2024, at 6:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Review and consider approval of the minutes of the September 9, 2024, Board of Directors meeting;
2. Consider the status of security patrol from the Harris County Sheriff's Office, the status of security monitoring services, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
3. Consider comments from members of the public;
4. Conduct a public hearing relative to the District's proposed maintenance and operations tax for 2024;
5. Consider the adoption and levy of the District's maintenance and operations tax for 2024, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
6. Consider the approval and execution of an Amendment to the Second Amended and Restated District Information Form;
7. Consider engagement of auditor for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2024, and the taking of any action required in connection therewith;
8. Status of solid waste collection services by Texas Pride Disposal, including review and approval of Amendment to Residential Solid Waste Collection Contract, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
9. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, and the taking of any action in connection therewith, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and approving the moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
10. Operator's Report, including:
 - a) Appeals of District charges;
 - b) Refer accounts for collection and approving write-off of uncollectible accounts; and
 - c) Report regarding status of maintenance projects, and the taking of any actions in connection therewith;
 - d) Status of repairs at Water Plant No. 2 including review and approval of proposals for security equipment and monitoring;
 - e) Consider status of FEMA reimbursement;

 - d) Report regarding maintenance of park property and trails and consider authorizing repairs relative to same;
 - e) Consider status of preparation of Geographic Information System for the District;
 - f) Consider authorization to advertise and/or solicit bids for the installation of pickleball court;
 - g) Status of plans, usage submittals and inspections from Mexcor;
 - h) Review and discussion of Capital Improvements Plan;
