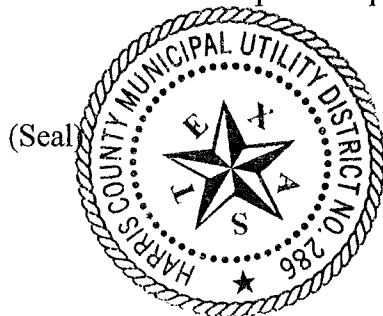
The meeting will be held on **Monday, September 14, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Review and consider approval of the minutes of the August 3, 2026, Board of Directors meeting;
2. Consider the status of security patrol from the Harris County Sheriff's Office, the status of security monitoring services, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
3. Consider comments from members of the public;
4. Consider status of request to Precinct 3 Commissioner for traffic control modifications;
5. Consider review and approval of Interlocal Agreement for Hike and Bike Trail between the District and Harris County Flood Control District;
6. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, and the taking of any action in connection therewith, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and approving the moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
7. Receive and take any action related to the Financial Advisor's recommendation concerning the establishment of the District's 2026 tax rate and consider proposal of District's 2026 tax rate and authorize publication of notice of public hearing relative to setting District tax rate;
8. Operator's Report, including:
 - a) Appeals of District charges;
 - b) Refer accounts for collection and approving write-off of uncollectible accounts; and
 - c) Report regarding status of maintenance projects, and the taking of any actions in connection therewith;
9. Consider status repairs to Water Plant No. 2 and relocation of Centerpoint line, and the taking of any other actions required in connection with same;

 - a) Report concerning bids and/or award of construction contract or concurrence in the award of a contract for the construction or repair of water, sanitary sewer, drainage and recreational facilities within the District; status of construction contracts, including the approval/concurrence of any change orders and/or acceptance of

 - h) Status of updated Emergency Preparedness Plan;
 - i) Consider proposal for preparation of AWIA Risk Assessment Plan, and authorize preparation of same;

*The District levies taxes in accordance with the Texas Water Code. The District's current operations and maintenance tax rate is equal to \$0.1000 per \$100 of assessed value. Average homestead values are determined by the county appraisal district. All estimates above were prepared utilizing the average resident homestead value as of the time that the District's most recent Truth in Taxation worksheet was prepared in accordance with the Texas Water Code.

**Average tax bill estimates for the current and proposed budgets reflect those taxes necessary to fund the operations and maintenance tax revenues stated in the applicable budget.

***This column estimates the operations and maintenance taxes to be paid on the average homestead if the proposed budget generates the same amount of operations and maintenance tax revenues as the current budget.

DISCLAIMER: This statement is prepared pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.043(c) as amended by House Bill 1522, 89th regular session. This District has used Texas Water Code equivalent calculations in place of the Tax Code, Chapter 26 "no-new-revenue tax rate" referenced in HB 1522 and has used average the homestead value as required by Texas Water Code Section 49.236 rather than the median homestead values specified in HB 1522. These modifications are necessary because the referenced Tax Code provisions do not apply to the District.
